




Make a Quarry

You don't need a huge garden to make your own quarry. A dish full of damp flour will do.

Half-fill a bowl with damp flour, sand or earth and let your little ones loose with their vehicles, diggers, spoons and cups. Add pebbles for boulders, or 'treasure', like buried dinosaurs, coins or beads.



Make a Finger Lake

Scoop your fingers through the 'soil' of your quarry. Can you see the bumps and hollows of your finger trails? You've made a Finger Lake shape!

You can also use toy diggers or trucks to excavate this Finger Lake shape.



When big diggers and excavators quarried out gravel at BRVP, they made the Finger Lake shape. Back then it was a noisy dusty place. Now the fingers are filled with water to make a place for peaceful fishing, walking and wildlife watching.
